The International M.A. program in Archaeology and History of the Land of the Bible offers a unique window into the archaeology and history of ancient Israel, its neighboring countries, and their perplexing and complex past. The program offers the opportunity to gain fieldwork experience in the most exciting excavations conducted in Israel by TAU scholars, while providing the most up-to-date, modern and scientific tools to the area's archaeological and historical studies. The program is the only one of its kind in Israel and in the world, allowing students from a variety of countries across the globe to study the archaeology and history of the land of the Bible – IN the land of the Bible.

ACADEMIC FOCUS

The program combines the study of archaeology and history with fieldwork experience in some of the world's most exciting excavations

- Coursework in the first two semesters focuses on the economic and social structures, political relations, and religious practices of the ancient inhabitants, as illuminated through ancient Near Eastern and Biblical texts
- Archaeological visits to prominent excavation sites such as Tel Megiddo, Tel Hatzor, Masada, and Qumran bring classroom study to life
- Four to six weeks of field excavation at an archaeological project conducted by TAU's Institute of Archaeology
