

PBC Scholarship Program for Outstanding Post-Doctoral Fellows – Program Closed

The PBC Fellowship Program for Outstanding Chinese and Indian Post-Doctoral Fellows

Objectives:

- To enable outstanding post-doctoral researchers from various fields to continue their training in Israel.
- To enhance academic cooperation and research collaboration with China and India.
- This program was part of Israel's policy to promote recruitment of international students and researchers.

Duration: A two-year scholarship.

Amount: 115,000 NIS per scholarship per academic year for two years: 69,000 NIS per year by the PBC, and no less than 41,000 NIS per year by the University. In addition, the university provided 5,000 NIS each year for travel expenses.

Number of Scholarships: Up to 55 scholarships were granted each year.

The recipients were selected on the basis of scientific and academic excellence by an evaluation committee established by the PBC.
